

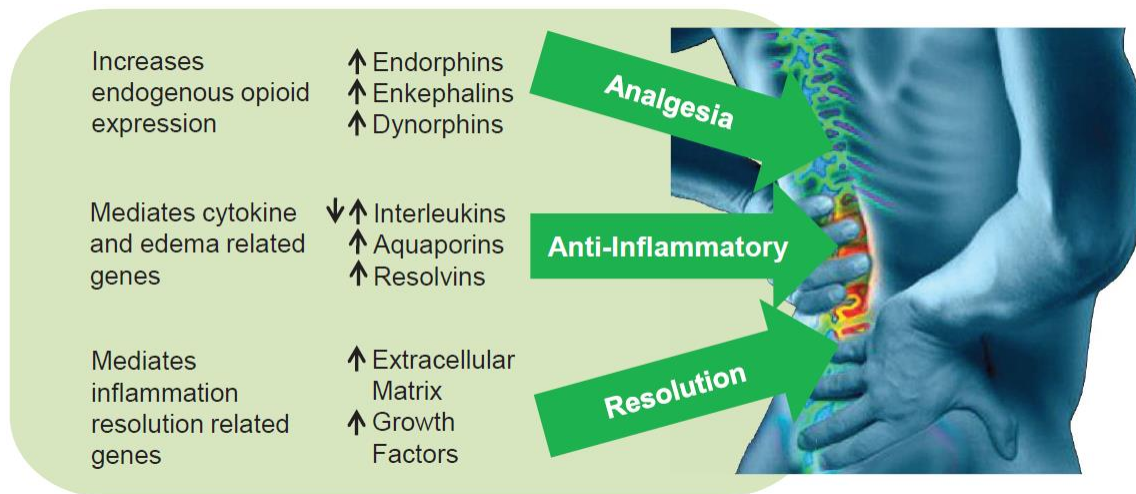
OPIOIDS MIGHT WORSEN PAIN IN THE LONG-TERM
