

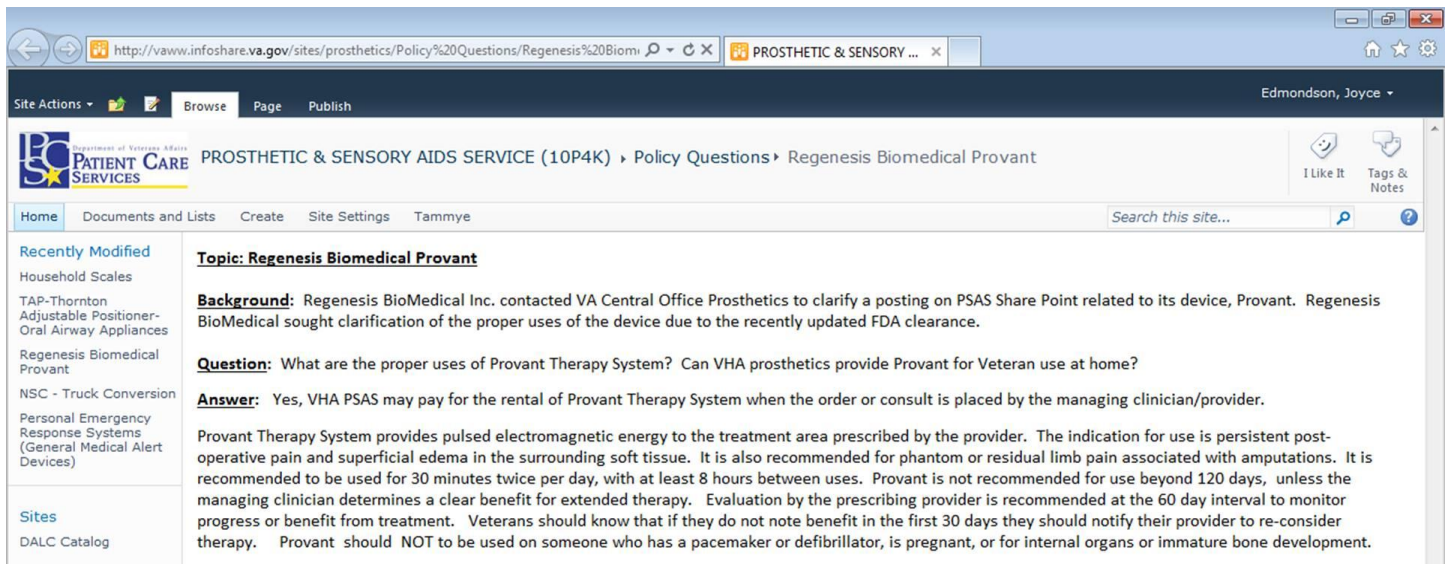


What are the proper uses of the Provant Therapy System?

Can VHA prosthetics provide Provant for Veteran use at home?

Recently the Veterans Affairs Central Office provided clarifying language on the appropriate use of Provant Therapy. The Central Office published a statement on its Share Point site that addressed Provant's indications and recommended length of treatment, identified the appropriate prescribers, and stated that the Prosthetics department will pay for Veteran use at home. At RegenesiS, our primary focus is to ensure that Veterans receive pain relief and the medical care they earned and deserve, so we supported this initiative.
