Prevention is a key, by managing pain with a range of treatments

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The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) just released a roadmap to address the opioid epidemic. PREVENTION

TREATMENT

Expand access to treatment for opioid use disorder



DATA

Use data to target prevention and treatment efforts and to identify fraud and abuse
